## RALLY ITALIA SARDEGNA 2016 ENTRY LISTS OPENED

Today opened the Rally Italia Sardegna 2016 entry lists that will close on the 9th of May.

The countdown has already started, only two months are left ahead of the Rally Italia Sardegna 2016, race scheduled from 9 to 12 June and valid as sixth round of the World Rally Championship. The event organized by Automobile Club d'Italia will feature 19 stages divided in three days for a total of 325,90 timed km. After the publication of the race regulations, entry lists opened today. The deadline for subscription is set for next May 9th.

- The original of the entry form and of the entry fee payment will have to be sent to Organizers by mail (via Stanis Dessy n.7 – 07041 Alghero) within seven days and in all cases before Monday May 16th 2016.
- Entries not accompanied by the entry fee payment or alternatively by a receipt issued by the Entrant's ASN will not be accepted.
- Entry requests not including the payment of entry fees will be considered void even if Organizers will not notify the entrant.

**A summary of the programme of the Rally Italia Sardegna 2016 follows.**

Edition 2016 of the Rally d'Italia, race organized by Automobile Club d'Italia with the support of Regione Sardegna, will feature an itinerary of 323,06 km divided in 19 stages. The headquarters of the event will be set up in Alghero again. The shakedown is scheduled for the morning of Thursday June 9th in Olmedo-Monte Baranta (4,28 km), and then the crews will run the opening 2 km long Super Special Stage Ittiri Arena at local 18.30. Drivers will then resume racing on Friday 10th from Alghero, running the 102,76 timed km of leg one split in 8 stages (4 to be repeated twice) located in the north side of the island. Ardara (7,50 km) will open the challenge and it will be followed by the new Tula (15 km) and by the two stages held in the past: Castelsardo (14 km) and Tergu (14,88 km). The four stages held in the morning will then be repeated in the afternoon following service park in Alghero. A very tough day two on Saturday will feature 6 stages (3 repeated twice), for a total of 177 timed km located around the Mount Acuto basin. Drivers will have to go through the stages Monti di Alà (21,20 km), Coiluna-Loelle (22,50 km) and Monte Lerno (44,80 km), that will be repeated in the afternoon after the service park in Alghero. The final day of the rally will feature only 41,30 timed km split in 4 stages. Two loops each will be run of the Cala Flumini (13,87 km) and of the brand new stage Sassari-Argentiera (6,78 km), which will also be the closing Power Stage featuring live on TV coverage at local 12.08.
